


Barbecues at Lydiard Park 2019/20

Terms and Conditions



Lydiard Park

1. Your payment is **non-refundable**.
2. If you do not turn up on the day, your booking will be lost.
3. If you need to **rearrange** your BBQ, or **cancel** due to bad weather, please inform us by telephone at least three days before your booking. Failure to do this will result in loss of your booking. We can transfer the booking to an alternative date within the current BBQ season **subject to availability**.
You must contact us within five days of the cancellation to rearrange or your booking will be lost.
4. If an alternative suitable date cannot be accommodated, a **voucher** will be issued during October and will be valid for one season only.
5. Booking is for **BBQ only**. Please bring your own coals, food and cooking utensils.
6. You are welcome to bring your own picnic chairs and one small gazebo (maximum size 2m x 2m).
7. Please **do not** bring bouncy castles, large gazebos, marquees, gas or disposable BBQs.
8. Please do not play loud music that may disturb other park users.
9. We welcome dogs, however from 1st April – 30th September please ensure your dog is on a lead in designated areas.
10. BBQs must be supervised by a responsible adult, aged 21 or over, at all times.
Groups of people under 16 years old will not be allowed to use our BBQ's unless they have adult supervision
11. BBQ/Picnic area is for use of all Park users– all users must respect the space and no group/organisation has priority over another.
12. No commercial or charity fundraising events are allowed in the BBQ area – food or other items are not allowed to be sold within the Park.
13. If you are planning a large gathering (more than 50-100 people) two adjoining BBQ pitches must be hired in order to provide sufficient space for your group and for our other BBQ users. Subject to availability.
14. During peak periods there are two bookings per BBQ per day. **IF YOU HAVE BOOKED FOR A LUNCH SESSION, PLEASE VACATE THE BBQ AND SURROUNDING AREA BY 3.00PM.**

BBQ hirers are responsible for clearing all litter from their pitch. We ask that you take litter home with you, or place it in the large metal bins provided on the perimeter of the field. Confetti and party streamers are also classed as litter and are prohibited from being used. You will be charged a fee of £50 for any litter clearance that has to be undertaken by the Estate & Parkland Team following your BBQ.
